

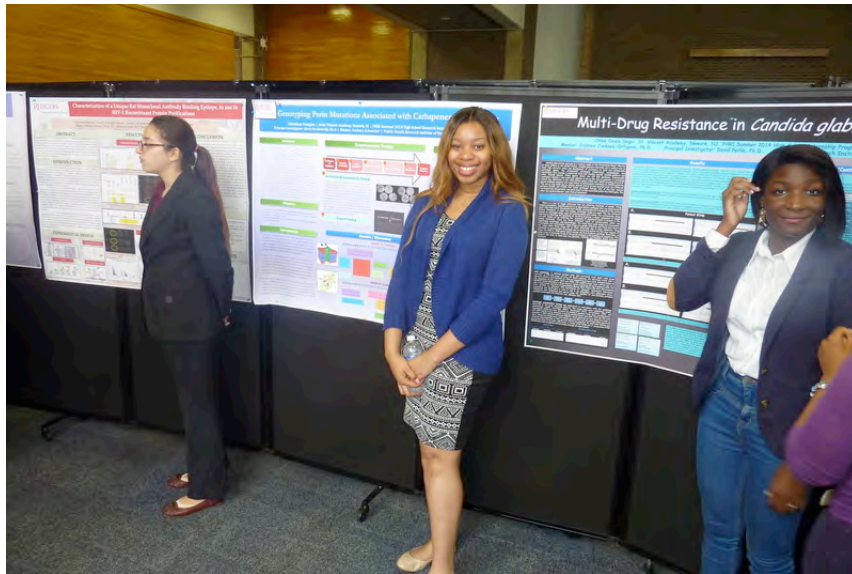
GS-LSAMP Conference Oct. 3, 2014

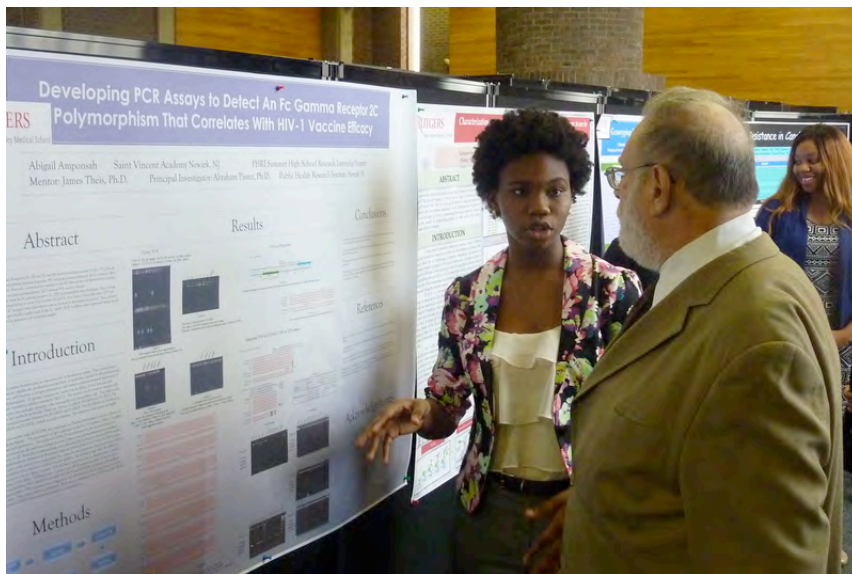

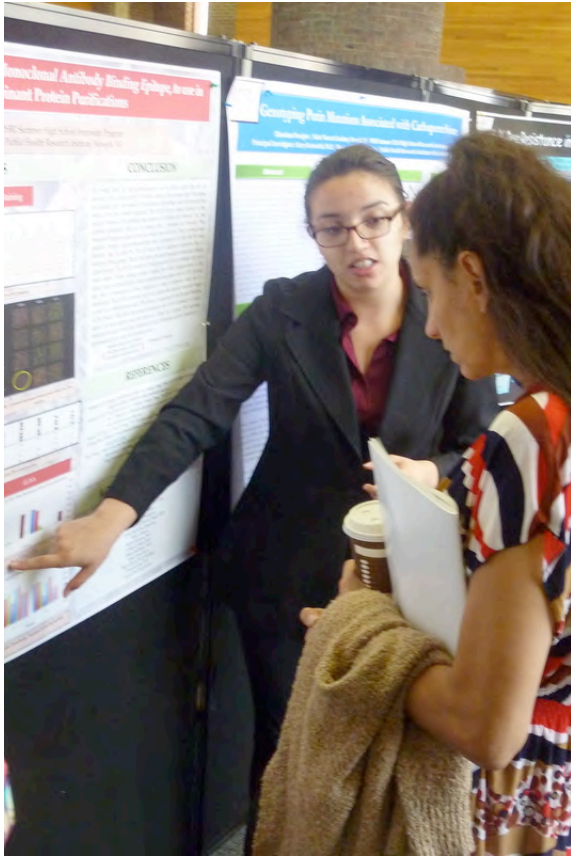

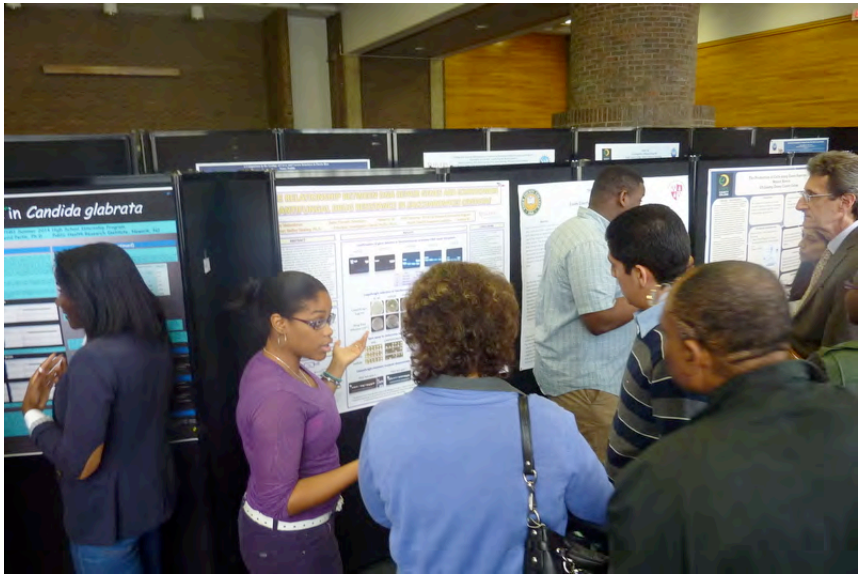

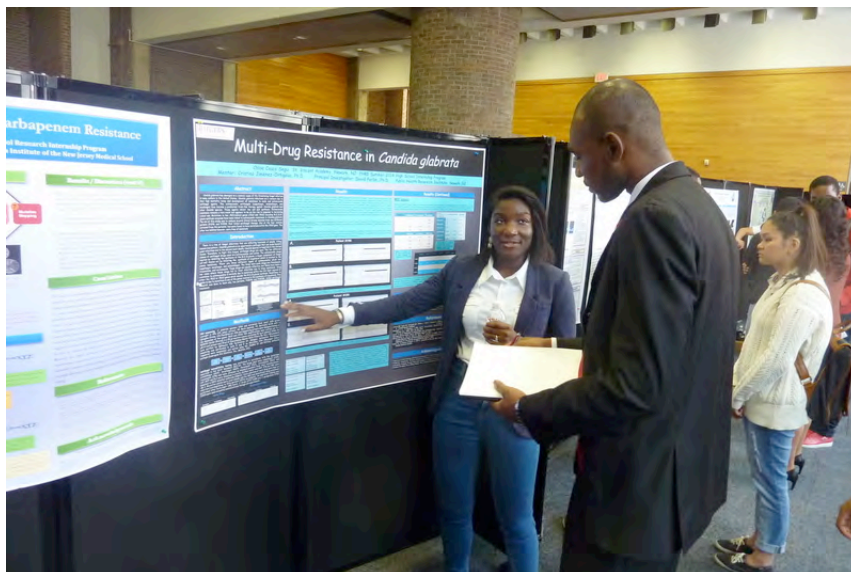

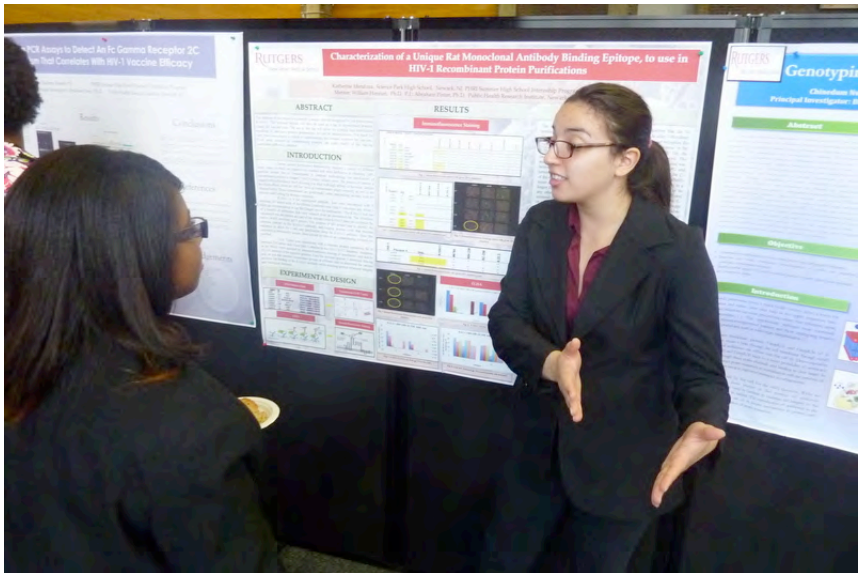
